

Our Year 1 Curriculum Map- Spring Term 1

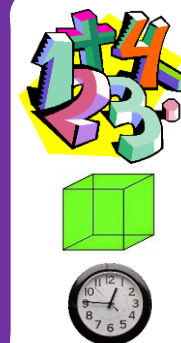
Literacy: **Reading:** Using our phonic skills to decode successfully. Learn about new phonics sounds (including split sounds) to blend with success. Developing our prediction, sequencing and retrieval skills by using simple pictures and small text extracts.

Writing: Incorporating writing to entertain/describe: Fiction (animal/ adventure stories) and Poetry/Rhymes. Developing our sentence structure to write successful sentences (a correct start and end).



Ongoing Literacy skills being covered: Reading (word level, phonics, comprehension and analysis), reading skills, writing (transcription, handwriting, composition, vocabulary, spelling, grammar and punctuation) and spoken language/oracy.

Maths: **Place Value:** To develop and deepen understanding of place value, recognising the value of digit in 2 digit numbers tens and units. Continue to understand vocabulary such as greater/ smaller/ less/ equals to. **Addition and Subtraction:** To continue to develop understanding of addition and subtraction and to consolidate the relationship between them. Deepen understanding of the number line. Use the multiples of 2, 5 and 10. Use reasoning problems to deepen understanding of place value and addition and subtraction. **Measurement:** Length and Height - Use different practical opportunities will be used to develop measuring skills. Make links back to place value and accuracy when counting.



Ongoing Maths skills being covered: Reasoning skills, Number (arithmetic, understanding mathematical vocabulary and basic times tables).

Science: **Everyday Materials:** To describe objects and their properties. Name everyday materials and comparing and grouping everyday objects.



Ongoing Science skills being covered: Focusing on our scientific enquiry types during investigations: identifying, classifying and grouping, observing over time, pattern seeking, researching and using secondary sources.

Physical Education (PE):

Target Games: Developing throwing and kicking skills.

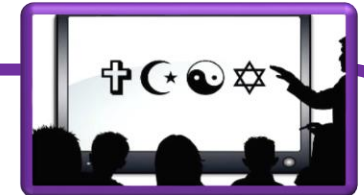
Geography:



Weather and Seasons: Learn about the weather patterns in our area. Learn about how the weather impacts what we can do-jobs/activities. Discuss the impact of the different seasons.
