

Our Year 3 Curriculum Map- Spring Term 1

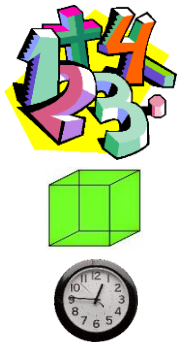
Literacy: **Reading:** Using pace, expression and fluency for more sustained reading. Refining our retrieval and inference skills by using images and texts/ looking deeper into a text. Looking at variety of test-type style questions to develop reading.

Writing: Writing to entertain: Develop understanding of character studies and developing narratives based on a story. Increasing understanding of paragraphing and fronted adverbial phrases.



Ongoing Literacy skills being covered: Reading (word level, phonics, comprehension and analysis), reading skills, writing (transcription, handwriting, composition, vocabulary, spelling, grammar and punctuation) and spoken language/oracy.

Maths: Multiplying 2 digits by 1 digit successfully. Use the 3, 4 and 8 times table and related division facts to solve problems. Use of arithmetic for multiplication and division leading to formal written methods. Learning to tell the time competently- solve problems using both digital and analogue.



Ongoing Maths skills being covered: Reasoning skills, Number (arithmetic, understanding mathematical vocabulary and basic times tables).

Science: **Light:** Develop understanding of what light actually is and what makes it. Explore-What is a shadow? Explore through our own investigations to deepen knowledge.



Ongoing Science skills being covered: Focusing on our scientific enquiry types during investigations: identifying, classifying and grouping, observing over time, pattern seeking, researching and using secondary sources.

Golf- Develop correct hold and swing techniques.



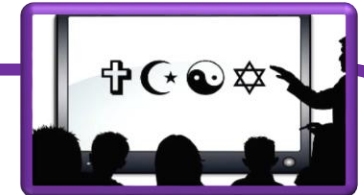
Geography:

Languages-Spanish:



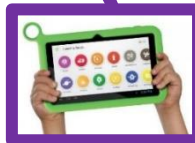
Animals: Build on previous Spanish knowledge. Learn the names for common animals. Talk, describe and give preferences.
