

Our Year 4 Curriculum Map- Autumn Term 1

Literacy: **Reading:** Using pace, expression and fluency with more precision during sustained reading.

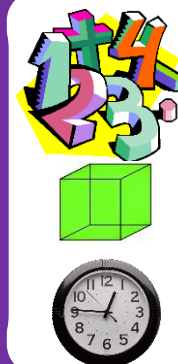
Refining our retrieval and inference skills by using images and texts/ looking deeper into a text.

Writing: Incorporating writing to entertain: Fiction (stories including dilemmas). Exploring sentence structure in different pieces of writing by using a range of different sentence types, punctuation and word classes.



Ongoing Literacy skills being covered: Reading (word level, phonics, comprehension and analysis), reading skills, writing (transcription, handwriting, composition, vocabulary, spelling, grammar and punctuation) and spoken language/oracy.

Maths: Number/ Place Value/ Addition and Subtraction- Using increased ability in number to navigate problem solving situations while applying different strategies (including pictorial and abstract approaches). Statistics- Constructing and interpreting graphs and diagrams with accuracy. Reading scales accurately. Use problem solving to fully demonstrate understanding.



Ongoing Maths skills being covered: Reasoning skills, Number (arithmetic, Key Instant Recall Facts, understanding mathematical vocabulary and basic times tables).

Science: Living things and their habitats: Simple Classification- Understanding the use of classification keys to help group, identify and name a variety of living things. Investigate the processes that living things follow.



Ongoing Science skills being covered: Focusing on our scientific enquiry types during investigations: identifying, classifying and grouping, observing over time, pattern seeking, researching and using secondary sources.

Physical Education (PE):

Real P.E: Personal skills, Coordination and static balance.
Fitness (exploring skills, actions and ideas).



Geography:

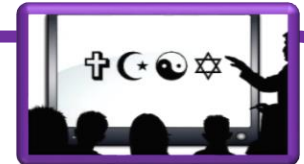


Climate Zones: Identify the different climate zones of the world and countries located in these zones. Learning and understanding about processes that cause the three major climate zones on the Earth (polar, temperate, and tropical).

Religious Education (RE):

What does it mean to be a Christian in Britain today? Explore and deepen knowledge of the key aspects of Christianity. Investigate what it means to be a practising Christian in Britain today.

All of our R.E units are linked to values and beliefs found in everyday life.
