

Our Year 4 Curriculum Map- Spring Term 1

Literacy: **Reading:** Using pace, expression and fluency with precision during sustained reading. Refining and deepening our retrieval and inference skills. Reading skills lesson will take place twice weekly. Pupils will focus on a range of skills; inference, retrieval, predicting and justifying.

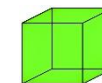
Writing: Writing to entertain: Develop understanding of character (emotions/feelings) and developing narratives based on a story. Increasing understanding of fronted adverbial phrases and using evidence from a text to inform writing. Writing in role: letter writing, thought bubbles, diary entry and a Narrative recount



Ongoing Literacy skills being covered: Reading (word level, phonics, comprehension and analysis), reading skills, writing (transcription, handwriting, composition, vocabulary, spelling, grammar and punctuation) and spoken language/oracy.

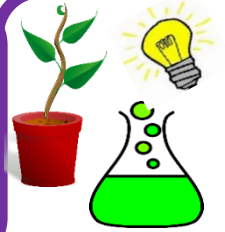
Maths: Learn to divide by 10 and 100. Use known division facts to divide multiples of 10 and 100. Learn about the multiplication grid method to solve complex problems.

Measurement- Explore length and perimeter. Learn how to find the area and perimeter of rectilinear shapes. Use and apply knowledge.



Ongoing Maths skills being covered: Reasoning skills, Number (arithmetic, understanding mathematical vocabulary and basic times tables).

Science: **Electricity:** Identify the common appliances that run on electricity. Learn how to make a simple series circuit and be able to name each part. Investigate how a switch works to control whether or not a lamp lights. Recognise some common conductors and insulators.



Ongoing Science skills being covered: Focusing on our scientific enquiry types during investigations: identifying, classifying and grouping, observing over time, pattern seeking, researching and using secondary sources.

Tag Rugby: Develop key skills and build up to game situations.

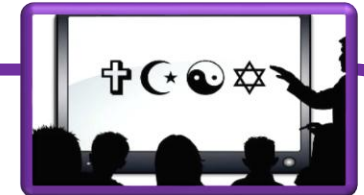


Geography:

PowerPoint skills: Developing an advanced slide show using typing and images.



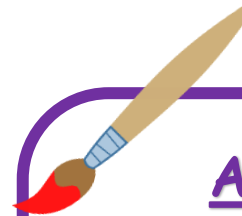
Personal, Social, Health, Economic (PSHE) Education:
