

Our Year 2 Curriculum Map- Autumn Term 1

Literacy: **Reading:** Using our phonic skills to decode successfully and read unfamiliar words.

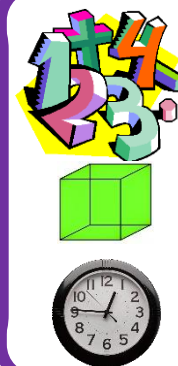
Developing our retrieval skills by using images/texts to gain meaning.

Writing: Incorporating writing to entertain: Fiction (stories with familiar settings and adventure stories).
Incorporating writing to inform: Non-fiction (Explanation). Understanding different word classes and how punctuation changes a sentence. Checking the consistency of our sentence structure



Ongoing Literacy skills being covered: Reading (word level, phonics, comprehension and analysis), reading skills, writing (transcription, handwriting, composition, vocabulary, spelling, grammar and punctuation) and spoken language/oracy.

Maths: The basics of Number- including in numerals and words. Place Value- Including the use of concrete resources and understanding the value of a digit in a 2-digit number. Addition and Subtraction- confidently using different strategies. Solve problems by initially using concrete resources moving onto pictorial / abstract approaches. Statistics- Constructing and interpreting pictograms and diagrams. Using problem solving to fully demonstrate understanding.



Ongoing Maths skills being covered: Reasoning skills, Number (arithmetic, Key Instant Recall Facts, understanding mathematical vocabulary and basic times tables).

Science: Living things and their habitats: Living and Dead- Understand about what living and dead actually means. Investigate and learn about how some things were once living. Discuss some of the processes that makes something a 'living being'.



Ongoing Science skills being covered: Focusing on our scientific enquiry types during investigations: identifying, classifying and grouping, observing over time, pattern seeking, researching and using secondary sources.

PE Fundamentals: Increase and develop the skills of Agility, Balance and Coordination.

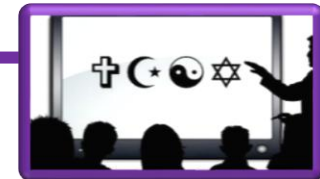
History:



Remembrance- Understanding why we have a war memorial in Chingford. Learn how the poppy is a symbol of remembrance (with a focus on the events in World War One).

Religious Education (RE):

Who is Muslim and how do they live? (Part 1)- Understand and learn about a religious faith. Find out about the key aspects of being a Muslim- How are their lives affected by their beliefs? **All of our R.E units are linked to values and beliefs found in everyday life.**

The historical context of musical styles and the effect it can have on people.

A Prelude to Spanish:

If You Are Happy and You Know It: An early introduction to the language of Spanish. Learning to say hello and use other ways to initiate a conversation and express feelings (through chanting and singing songs together).



Computing:

Class Artist: Developing computing skills that explore artwork by the class artist.

Online Safety: Understanding the key basics of staying safe while being online.
