Memorise a sentence each week that uses the maths vocabulary accurately.

Word	Sentence to memorise
Thousandth	A thousandth is the position of the third digit to the right of the decimal place.
Inverse	The inverse is the opposite of another operation.
Common factor	A common factor is a number that can be divided into two different numbers, without leaving a remainder.
Common multiple	Common multiples are multiples which are the same for two different numbers.
Mixed operations	Mixed operations are problems where two or more different operations are used.
Order of operations	The order of operations tells you how to solve a problem with mixed operations.
